
IMAGERY

We would love to feature images of your home on our site. So as recent renovation finishers, you can inspire the new homeowners and those re-renovating, helping to assist them with their interior design plans.

For our 'real homes look book' we would require between 10-30 images. If you can send more that would be great. We would accept a maximum of 50 images, which gives us more to choose from. Before and After pictures are also desirable but not required.

ALL THINGS LOVELY

Your images are beautiful and capture the timeless designs of your home. We would like to showcase them and in turn inspire all those home renovators with how they can design and style their dream home.





It's great to show a variety of images and so we suggest frames that capture the following:

- the outside of the house – including the garden
- décor and styling
- the little details – taps, shutters, doorways
- table sets
- photographs of you using the space if appropriate to show reasons behind the design
- bedroom
- living space
- kitchen
- hallway
- any interesting features, such as a statement chair, piece of artwork or crazy floorcovering

*Of course we know that some of the above may not be relevant to your home, but if you could give us as much variety as possible that would be fantastic. That way we can really get a feel for the story behind the design.

SENDING YOUR IMAGES

Please note that although you do not need to be a professional photographer, the images do need to be of a certain quality. The easiest way to send your photos is via Dropbox or We Transfer. They are both free up to a certain limit and means you can send the same quality of images as originally taken. If you don't know how to do it yourself, ask your photographer, or someone with photography experience if they can send them for you.


At the moment we can only accept jpeg images.

Please make sure they are saved for web with a resolution quality of 60. Portrait images must be 1500px high x 1000px wide. Landscape images must be 1600px wide. We also require a Banner Image at 2100px wide and approximately 1000px high.*

Should you really want to feature your home, but cannot take appropriate images, we can provide a photography service for a small fee. If this interests you, then please contact us first via email, along with basic images of your home at submissions@houseofthree.co.uk

Along with your images we would need to ask you to complete a questionnaire to assist with the feature content. This will help to inspire every else and really help capture the story behind your interior design.


