For our ' real weddings look book' we would require between 20-50 images. If you can send more that would be great. We would accept a maximum of 100 images, which gives us more to choose from.

Your images are beautiful and capture the magical moments of your day. We would like to showcase them and in turn inspire all those brides and grooms to be with how they can plan their dream day.

- décor, styling and any general theming
- the brides attire & accessories

- flowers including bouquets, buttonholes, large decorative arrangements & table centres
- those important guests
- cake table or dessert station
- canape or food close ups

- stationery including table plan, place settings & table names or numbers

*Of course we know that some of the above may not be appropriate to your wedding, but if you could give us as much variety as possible that would be fantastic. That way we can really get a feel for your special day.

It's great to show a variety of images and so we suggest frames that capture the following:

SENDING YOUR IMAGES

The easiest way to send your photos is via Dropbox or We Transfer. They are both free up to a certain limit and means you can send the same quality of images as originally taken. If you don't know how to do it yourself, ask your photographer if they can send them for you.

At the moment we can only accept jpeg images.

Please make sure they are saved for web with a resolution quality of 60. Portrait images must be 1500px high x 1000px wide. Landscape images must be 1600px wide. We also require a Banner Image at 2100px wide and approximately 1000px high.*

Along with your images we would need to ask you to complete a questionnaire to assist with the feature content. This will help to inspire every one else and really help capture the special moments of your day.



TIME TO GET TO KNOW YOUR STORY



You are newly weds (5 years still counts as a newly wed) and so you are the most important people in helping to inspire future weddings. We therefore ask you if you could share with us all of those special parts of both your planning process and your day. This will include the bits that were hard (so we can write about easier ways), the bits that were easy and most importantly, your favourite and most special parts of the process.
